- **ONLY** South African citizens are allowed to enter for Opulent Models South Africa. Entrants must have a valid passport/SA ID or Birth Certificate.

1. You will be disqualified if any of the following rules of Opulent Models South Africa are broken.
2. You are to always advertise Opulent Models South Africa in a positive manner and you will not be allowed to slander Opulent Models South Africa's name, or any member of the Opulent Models South Africa team.
3. You will receive valuable workshops and training by highly skilled professionals. Some of these workshops or events will be compulsory to attend as a semi-finalist or finalist.
4. You need to always act professional.
5. All semi-finalists and finalists will be required to sell tickets for the events such as the round of the semi-finals and Grand Finale. Please note you will not be allowed to compete in Opulent Models South Africa if you have not sold all your tickets if decided otherwise.
6. Contestants and parents are expected to behave in a professional manner and any interference, whatever the nature, shall not be tolerated.

7. Contestants agree that they do not have the right to make any press releases whatsoever, without the consent of the organisers.
8. You will receive a reference letter from Opulent Models South Africa which you can use when sending your CV to companies for future job applications.
9. Opulent Models South Africa are not responsible for any injuries or expenses of being a selected contestant for our competition.
- 10. A R1000 is paid upfront if selected as a finalist for Opulent Models South Africa. The R1000 is paid in full when signing your finalist contract with the purpose of serving as your penalty fee when withdrawing as finalist. The R1000 will only be paid back in full after you've participated in our Opulent Models South Africa Grand Finale.**
11. Prizes received during the contestant's journey are not refundable for cash.
12. Judging criteria is as per international standards.
13. The judges' decision is final where Opulent Models South Africa will appoint a male and female model winner for South Africa.
14. Please take note any prizes and goodies you received during your journey with Opulent Models needs to be promoted on social-media from the sponsorship and relevant brands and companies needs to be tagged-in.
15. All finalists that will be going through to the Grand Finale will have to attend a full-day workshop to the value of R4449 where they will receive training from accredited industry speakers.
16. Entry fee, workshop fee and sold Grand Finale tickets are non-refundable should the grand finale or workshop be cancelled or postponed due to the following reasons/factors, which may include but are not limited to,

GENERAL RULES AND REQUIREMENTS AS A WINNER FOR OPULENT MODELS

SOUTH AFRICA:

1. All Opulent Models South Africa winner(s) could be signed by agencies.
2. The winner(s) will be promoted through Opulent Models South Africa and will sign a 12-month contract.
3. All official interviews conducted by the winner(s) are mandatory.
4. Opulent Models South Africa are not responsible for any injuries or expenses of the winner(s).
5. Opulent Models South Africa may use images of the finalist(s) & winner(s) at all times.
6. If the winner(s) conduct themselves in a manner not befitting the title, they will be disqualified, and a suitable replacement will be selected.
 - If the winner is disqualified or chooses to relinquish the title, all prizes, awards and cash value shall be returned in full to be given to the next choice of the judges.
7. The winner(s) will be available for their sponsors for appearances for free, if decided otherwise.
